1. **How can I apply for the positions available through the 2013 School Investment Program?** Those interested in working on the 2013 School Investment Program should attend one of the four community intake sessions being held throughout the City of Chicago. Details are below:

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2. **Do I need to attend all four sessions?** No, you do not need to apply at all four sessions. Once you have applied at one session, your information will be stored and will be available to the Design Build Teams.
3. **What kinds of jobs are available through this program?** The Design Build Teams are looking for skilled trade workers and non-construction related staff. We anticipate a demand for carpenters, electricians, and painters.
4. **If I am an apprentice or a journeyman, may I apply?** Yes, apprentices or journeymen are encouraged to apply.
5. **What do I need to bring to the community intake session?** Please bring a COPY of:
(1) photo identification (driver's license or state ID), a resume (if available), and a copy of your union card, certifications and/or credentials (if available and/or applicable). Copies will not be made on site.
6. **Where can I park?** All four locations have accessible parking for attendees. Additionally, all sessions are accessible by public transportation.
7. **If I applied at a community intake session for a previous PBC project, do I have to apply?** Yes, those interested in working on the 2013 School Investment Program should attend one of the four community intake sessions being held throughout the City of Chicago.
8. **Can I attend the community intake sessions to discuss positions for CPS students?** The work available for CPS students is being managed by the Chicago Public Schools' Career Technical Institute (CTE). Applications will not be accepted for CPS students at these application intake sessions.
9. **Can I apply online?** No, you will need to attend one of the four community intake sessions to apply for work related to the 2013 School Investment Program.
10. **Will the PBC be hiring for the 2013 School Investment Program?** No, the 17 Design Build Teams approved for the 2013 School Investment Program will conduct the actual hiring. The Public Building Commission does not endorse nor promote any particular candidate for employment or potential employer.
11. **Are these permanent positions?** The positions are temporary for construction work involved in the 2013 School Investment program, which will take place this summer starting June 26th.
