South Loop Elementary School Community Hiring Areas

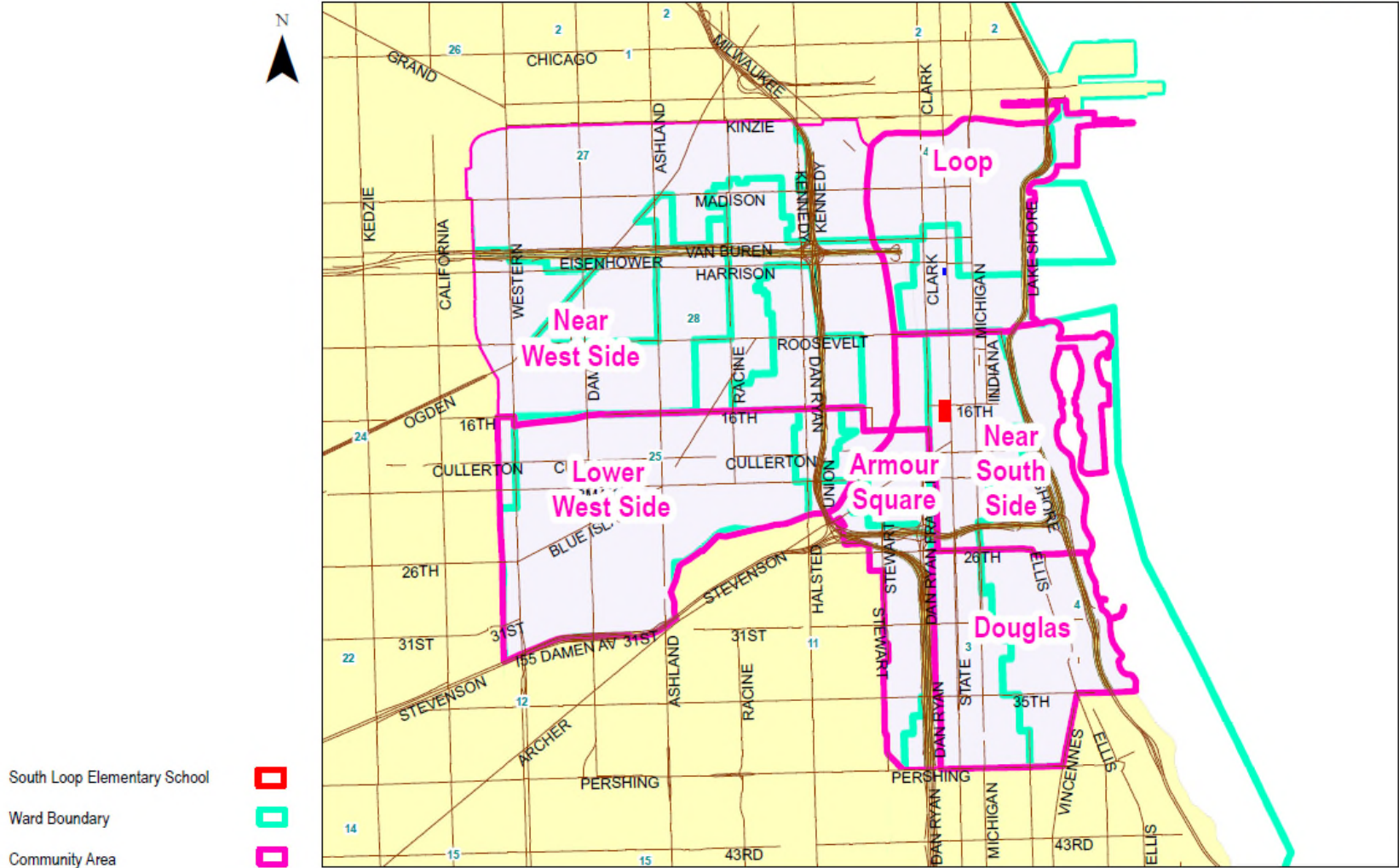
