The successful General Contractor will be required to return a compliant Certificate of Insurance and Payment and Performance Bond within seven (7) days of the issuance of the Notice of Award.

Further, within two weeks of the issuance of the Notice of Award, the successful General Contractor shall be required to prepare and submit all Construction Submittal documentation, including but not limited to: Stormwater Detention Tank, Steel Fabrication and Steel Erection Work.
