

- Do I need to attend both sessions? No, you do not need to apply at both sessions.
 Once you have applied at one session, your information will be stored and will be available to the General Contractor.
- What kinds of jobs are available through this program? The General Contractor is looking for skilled trade workers and non-construction related staff. We anticipate a demand for carpenters, masons, HVAC and electricians.
- If I am an apprentice or a journeyman, may I apply? Yes, apprentices or journeymen are encouraged to apply.
- 4. What do I need to bring to the community intake session? Please bring a COPY of: (1) current photo identificiation (driver's license or state ID), a resume (if applicable), and a copy of your union card, certifications and/or credentials (if available and/or applicable).
- 5. Do I have to live in a community area to apply for a job? The Public Building Commission is committed to having residents who live in the community work on the projects being built or renovated in their community. The PBC has contract provisions that require at least 50% of the labor force be local residents.
