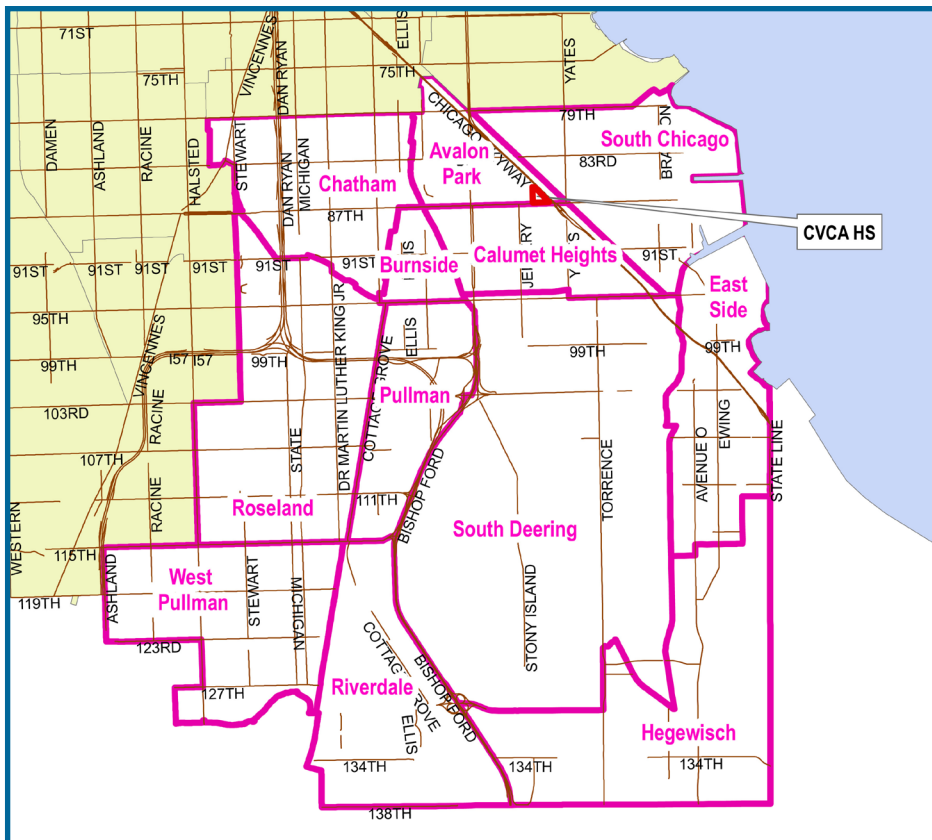

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. **Do I need to attend one of these sessions if I applied in 2014?** No, you do not need to come to any session if you applied at the February 27, 2014 or March 6, 2014 sessions. Once you have applied at one session, your information will be stored and will be available to the General Contractor.
2. **If I want to apply, do I need to come to both sessions?** No, you only need to attend one session.
3. **What kinds of jobs are available through this program?** The General Contractor is looking for skilled trade workers and non-construction related staff.
4. **If I am an apprentice or a journeyman, may I apply?** Yes, apprentices or journeymen are encouraged to apply.
5. **What do I need to bring to the community intake session?** Please bring a COPY of: (1) current photo identification (driver's license or state ID), a résumé (if applicable), and a copy of your union card, certifications and/or credentials (if available and/or applicable).
6. **Do I have to live in a community area to apply for a job?** The Public Building Commission is committed to having residents who live in the community work on the projects being built or renovated in their community. The PBC has contract provisions that require at least 50% of the labor force be local residents.
7. **What community areas are included in this project?**
