MWRD: **Energy Efficiency Program**



Project Scope

- Comprehensive energy efficiency initiative focused on increasing energy performance of MWRD treatment facility buildings.
- PBC will oversee two-part planning process: Feasibility & Investment Grade Audit
- Utilizes specialized Energy Service Companies (ESCOs), to identify, design, and implement economically feasible energy-related capital improvements.
- Guaranteed Energy Performance Contracting used insure all energy savings projects are monitored, verified, and guaranteed to generate sufficient savings to repay costs within the payback period.
- Program will improve energy efficiency of buildings at six waste water treatment sites in Cook County: Stickney, Calumet, Terrence O'Brien, Kirie, Egan, and Hanover Park
